

Height of His Galilean Ministry - Mark 4 begins with the parable of the four soils



Jesus tells them to make way for the other shore, and a small armada sails with them.



Mark 4:35ff



Jesus is in the stern asleep on the helmsman's pillow.



"When Jesus was awakened to meet the storm, He was in perfect peace. There was no trace of fear in word or look, for no fear was in His heart. But He rested not in the possession of almighty power. It was not as the "Master of earth and sea and sky" that He reposed in quiet. That power He had laid down, and He says, "I can of Mine own self do nothing." John 5:30. He trusted in the Father's might. It was in faith—faith in God's love and care—that Jesus rested, and the power of that word which stilled the storm was the power of God." - DA 335



Jesus stills the storm with a word and encourages the disciples to have more faith... but the Bible describes their fear was heightened after His revelation of power.

The Demoniac healed - Mark 5





The devil had intended for Jesus and His disciples to drown in the sea, but the legion of demons ended up drowning of their own choice after Jesus expelled them. Jesus displayed God's power over the evil forces of darkness.



"Meanwhile a marvelous change had come over the demoniacs. Light had shone into their minds. Their eyes beamed with intelligence. The countenances, so long deformed into the image of Satan, became suddenly mild, the bloodstained hands were quiet, and with glad voices the men praised God for their deliverance." - DA 338



Power - We can accomplish whatever God asks us to do when we rely upon His strength, no matter what circumstances we are faced with. (See Philippians 4:13,19; 2 Corinthians 12:7-9.)

Love - We are to love one another as Jesus has loved us. John 13 makes it clear that Jesus was able to be focused on serving others because of the security He had from knowing where He came from, where He was going and why He was here (John 13:1-3, 13-15, 34,35).

Sound mind - Jesus said, "Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid (deliao)" John 14:27. The fruit of the Spirit includes all the qualities that make up a balanced, healthy mind (Galatians 5:22,23).
