We currently serve mainly families with young children, and the program is breaking records with the number of people currently being served. One third of the clients are first timers, and the two thirds being served are regular customers.

Food Pantry Volunteer Positions

Registration Coordinators - help families check in and complete paperwork.

Parking Lot Attendants/Greeters - help families park and direct them to the pantry area.

Hostess - organizes the food for distribution.

Runners - help take the bagged food to cars.

Bag Coordinators - get the bread ready for distribution.

Baggers - put food into the bags.

Veggie Baggers - bag the vegetables for small/medium/large families.

Refrigerator Baggers - bag the refrigerated food

Miscellaneous Table - sit at a table that holds various donated items that are available for clients

Drivers are needed on the second Wednesday of each month to bring items from the Food Bank to Woodside. Drivers must have a large vehicle and be at the Food Bank at 8:30 a.m. This is a scheduled position. If you are interested, see Elena or Paula for more information.
